

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What do I do if I'm building a home in Crescent?**

You will need to get permits from Oneida County Planning and Zoning (715-369-6130). You will also need a Uniform Dwelling Code Building permit and have your home inspected as it is being built. The Rhineland Fire Department/Building Inspector has contracted with the Town of Crescent for this service and can be reached at 715-365-8600.

You will also need a driveway permit application and address application which you will find on this site under Forms. Return both forms with check to town clerk. Address will be assigned by the county and town crew will put up address sign.

### **Can I subdivide my land?**

The Town of Crescent has a Subdivision Ordinance (see ordinances). The Plan Commission and Town Board must approve any land divisions. The Plan Commission meets the third Wednesday of the month and you must call the clerk to be included on the agenda the week prior to the meeting. Copies of all information must also be sent to clerk to be mailed to Plan Commission members.

### **Garbage Pickup**

The Town of Crescent does not provide garbage pickup for residents.

### **Town Meetings**

The Annual Town Meeting is held the third Tuesday of April, usually. The Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting of Electors are held late November or early December. Watch newspaper and posting sites for notices.

### **Town Board Meetings and Committee Meetings**

Town Board Meetings are scheduled for the second Wednesday of the month at 6:00 p.m., at the Town Hall, 3231 Golf Course Road, Rhineland. Agendas are posted at least 24 hours prior to the meeting on this website and at the Crescent Town Hall, 3231 Golf Course Road.

### **Does the town offer snowplowing for private driveways?**

No, it does not.

### **Paying Property Taxes**

Property taxes are paid to the town treasurer in December and January. The balance that is due at the end of July is paid to the county treasurer at the courthouse. Check your tax bill for information about tax collection.
