CALL TO ORDER

Chair Hartman called the Annual Town Meeting to Order at 5:00 p.m.

FINANCIAL REPORT

- Financial report was presented and electors were asked if there were any questions. No questions or discussion. Hartman reported that there will be a complete reassessment of Crescent properties and all property owners should expect to see the Town Assessor this summer. Hartman gave an overview of the assessment process.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS THAT LAWFULLY COMES BEFORE THE BOARD

- Connie Anderson asked where the town is at with the Wake Boat Ordinance. Jacobson stated that the ordinance was passed in October, 2026. The DNR has stated that the ordinance is unenforceable as written, however, the board was clear last year that the ordinance would not be enforceable. Discussion about posting the ordinance at the boat landings. The ordinance is available on the Town of Crescent website. Mehring asked that they be allowed to post the ordinance on the retaining wall in addition to the posting board. The board agreed that posting the ordinance on the retaining wall would not cause an issue.
- Hartman reported that the Town received a permit to replace the Gudis boat landing and we are waiting for the contractor to begin work.
- Mehring asked if the pier would be put back into Squash Lake. Hartman confirmed that it would be put back into the lake. Discussion regarding where the pier would be located.
- Mary Ann Newman asked if there could be cameras put up on S. River Road and catch who is throwing beer cans along the road.
